-Jesus-

The people were bugging and saying things like “If you are the Messiah then save yourself!” But Jesus did not do it because He loved us all so much and wanted to save us more than He wanted to save himself. So He just suffered all the mocking quietly without saying anything.

-The First Robber-

He probably didn’t believe in Jesus because he was saying nasty things to Jesus, like “If you are the Messiah, you should save yourself and us!”

-The Second Robber-

He didn’t believe in Jesus in the beginning but when he was on the cross something in his heart changed and he saw Jesus’ love. And he saw that Jesus wasn’t getting mad and suddenly he knew that Jesus was the Messiah. He might have been thinking that Jesus shouldn’t be the one to suffer but only he and the other robber should suffer because they did something wrong and Jesus just loves.

I sometimes feel bad because Jesus had to die for all the sins I do, when He didn’t even do anything. But I know, but sometimes forget, that Jesus only wants me to love Him back and that is the best present that I could give Him. Just like the second robber did. ☺
