Date: Thursday May.10th 2012

Theme: Cross/New Creation (Dead to Sin, Alive in Christ)

Scripture: The Crucifixion, 2 Corinthians 5:16-21, Romans 6:2-4

Prayer:

Open with prayer ask:

Read:

Read the text in two different translations
(EG: NIV and the Message)

Leader Suggestion:

Use spy paper to illustrate God's taking away of our sins

Personal Reflection Time:

Allow 15-20 minutes for personal reflection and journaling

Have students answer these 3 Questions in their journals:

1. God what verses do want to use to speak to me today?
2. God what are you teaching/revealing through these verses?
3. God what do want me to do now in light of this?

Reflection Questions:

Why did Jesus need to die on the cross for our sins?

What has happened for us because of the cross?

How are we supposed to live now that we are free from our bondage of sin?

Closing Prayer:
